## **STATEMENT ON EPA'S CLEAN AIR ACT RETROSPECTIVE**

Richard L. Revesz, dean of New York University School of Law and the faculty director of the Institute for Policy Integrity:

Americans gain more than a trillion dollars in economic benefits every year thanks to the Clean Air Act. If attempts to slow down or roll back these protections are successful, American families will lose huge amounts of value in return for a paltry donation to the industries that generate dangerous pollutants. Without these public health protections, corporate shareholders may face slightly lower compliance costs, but the American public will pick up a hefty tab.
