Fellow Position at the Institute for Policy Integrity at NYU School of Law

The Institute for Policy Integrity—a non-partisan think tank housed at New York University School of Law (www.policyintegrity.org)— is seeking a postdoctoral research fellow in economics/engineering. Policy Integrity is dedicated to improving the quality of government decisionmaking through advocacy and scholarship in the fields of administrative law, economics, and public policy. We work to identify and support economically sound policies related to energy, the environment, public health, and safety.

Fellows will collaborate with legal and economic researchers to prepare policy reports, briefs, and journal articles on a variety of issues including energy and climate policy, electricity market design, and retail electricity pricing. The ideal candidate should have a focus on policy-oriented, interdisciplinary research in environmental or resource economics, utility regulation, energy economics and policy, electricity market design, or retail electricity pricing. Fellows will be expected to model wholesale and retail electricity markets, analyze proposed market rule changes, and provide insights to inform policymaking.

Strong programming skills, knowledge of statistical software, and ease with big-data methods are required (e.g. R, Python, Julia, Go, etc.). Excellent written communication skills are essential.

Applicants should hold a Ph.D. by July 2019. The appointment is from August 2019 to July 2020, with the option to renew for a second year. Fellows will have the opportunity to engage in independent research.

Initial interviews will be conducted at the ASSA Meetings January 4 - 6, 2019 in Atlanta, Georgia. Interested applicants should apply using [this link](#) by November 23rd, 2018.
