Fellow Positions at the Institute for Policy Integrity at NYU School of Law

The Institute for Policy Integrity—a non-partisan think tank housed at New York University School of Law (www.policyintegrity.org)—is seeking 1-2 postdoctoral research fellows in economics. Policy Integrity is dedicated to improving the quality of government decisionmaking through advocacy and scholarship in the fields of administrative law, economics, and public policy. We work to identify and support economically sound policies related to energy, the environment, public health, and safety.

Fellows will collaborate with legal and economic researchers to prepare policy reports, briefs, and journal articles on a variety of issues including energy and climate policy, natural resources management, electricity market design, and benefit-cost analysis. The ideal candidate should have a focus on policy-oriented research in one of the following areas: (1) environmental or resource economics; or (2) utility regulation, energy economics/policy, and electricity market design/pricing. Programming, big-data analytics, and numerical optimization skills are a plus. Excellent written communication skills required.

Applicants should hold a Ph.D. in economics or a related field by July 2019. The appointment is for August 2019 to July 2020, with the option to renew for a second year. Fellows will have the opportunity to engage in independent research.
